We plan to debut our new set by LIVE streaming the NH Gives broadcast on June 7th and 8th. We hope you'll tune in. NH Gives is an important fundraising effort for over 500 nonprofits throughout the state to raise critical funds for their organizations. We're proud and humbled to be the broadcast hub for all participating New Hampshire nonprofits and to offer our new state-of-the-art studio for these 24 hours of giving.

Beyond NH Gives, NH author Rebecca Rule and our production team are discovering new stories from Nottingham for another installment in the OUR HOMETOWN series. THE STATE WE'RE IN remote crew is lining up expert guests to have critical conversations on issues that impact New Hampshire residents. And the GRANITE STATE CHALLENGE team is looking forward to putting our new set into action with 16 high school teams vying to be the GSC champion.


### Hotel Portofino SAT Jun 19 | 8 PM NHPBS
