Our locally produced programs continue to be a source of pride for us and loyalty and popularity with you, our viewers. WINDOWS TO THE WILD saw another season of thoughtful storytelling and sumptuous visuals, steered by the charm and wit of Willem Lange and bolstered by glorious destinations, including the White Mountains, Ireland and the Maine coastline.
