Did you know that NHPBS is integral to the safety and well-being of the Granite State? You often hear us talk about the importance of keeping the community informed in the context of unbiased news programming like FRONTLINE or THE STATE WE'RE IN, but PBS stations like ours also provide vital and irreplaceable emergency broadcasting during critical events.

The words "emergency broadcast system" might be inextricably linked in your mind with the high-pitched test that occassionally interrupts your TV viewing, but that minor inconvenience serves an important role in keeping us safe. During severe weather, natural disasters and public safety threats, the emergency broadcast system provides essential real-time information. You may have used it to keep track of the path of severe thunderstorms in the past. In times of crises, the absence of this system would leave a dangerous communication void.

Our role in public safety has also evolved as methods of communication have changed. The interconnection technology that connects local stations like ours to PBS is one of the backbone pathways for the delivery of the nation's Wireless Emergency Alert (WEA) services, The WEA enables cell phone subscribers to receive geotargeted text alerts, including AMBER Alerts, no matter where they are in the country. During the fires in Los Angeles this January, these alerts were a lifeline to countless people as the WEA allowed them precious extra moments to reach safety.

When you support NHPBS, you don't just make the Granite State safer, you also help ensure that our future remains bright. Recently, Marc Brown, the creator of *Arthur*, a children's book turned iconic PBS KIDS show, said it best: "About 50% of children in America are not enrolled in preschool. Given that the unregulated digital landscape for kids can be toxic, dangerous and for profit...public media is the last safe place for our children."

Brown said this in a recent *USA Today* op-ed, where he also noted that PBS KIDS programs "are created with child psychologists and education experts to ensure the betterment of all children." This attention to detail may be why PBS was ranked #1 by parents for helping prepare their little ones for school.

With your help, NHPBS supports learners throughout their school careers, providing access to resources that go beyond your television screen. For example, the PBS LearningMedia website is a favorite with educators and students, including homeschoolers, because it provides free access to tens of thousands of state standards-aligned learning materials. By making these high quality resources available to everyone, we're able to engage children in learning regardless of their income level, so they have the tools they need to succeed as adults.

Like you, I cherish my favorite shows on NHPBS – whether I'm getting my news from the PBS NEWSHOUR or relaxing with a quirky drama like DEATH IN PARADISE. But I also know that NHPBS is more than a media outlet, Public media is a resource for all of us and, as it faces an uncertain funding landscape, it's up to all of us to protect it.

NHPBS may not be flashy, but our mission is timeless. The joy of NHPBS – whether you're the CEO or a






